Whole School Visit to Countryside Live, Ledsham – Thursday 18 May 2017

On Thursday 18 May, the whole school will be taking part in the Countryside Live Event to be held at The Ledston Estate, Ledsham. This is a fantastic event which celebrates all things rural. The children will be involved in several events including a dancing sheep show, a flying birds of prey exhibition and a working gundogs exhibition.

We will be travelling by coach with seatbelts and will depart school straight after morning registration. Pupils will need to wear trousers that you don't mind getting dirty – we will be outside all day – and their school uniform tops. They will also need to wear strong shoes/boots and bring a waterproof coat and a drinks bottle in a back pack. We will return to school in time for going home. Please inform school of any specific special needs.

When organising school visits to enrich the curriculum and the education experience of the children school invites parents to contribute to the cost and we are asking parents/carers to contribute £8.00 per child. All contributions are voluntary, regretfully; if sufficient contributions are not received the school will have to consider cancelling the visit. Please log on to your ParentPay account to pay and to give your permission for school to take your child on this event. We cannot take anyone without permission.

From 1 April 2017 the cost of school visits for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium will be subsidized by school. Please logon to your ParentPay account to give permission and to pay the reduced amount. School will automatically top up this amount from the Pupil Premium funding.

Mrs Jones will provide a packed lunch for school dinner on this day. This is free of charge for all Key Stage 1 pupils and pupils in receipt of free school meals and costs £2.10 per pupil for those in Key Stage 2. The packed lunch consists of:
