Year 6 and Reception Visit to Harewood House, 2 October 2017

On Monday 2nd October, Year 6 and Reception pupils will be visiting Harewood House, Leeds. We will leave school at 9.00am and return to school for the usual time of 3:15pm. We will be travelling by private coach with seatbelts.

For Foundation pupils we will be taking the opportunity to look at how Autumn effects the park and find signs of the changing season. Whilst Year 6 will be given time to visit the sculpture garden and see how the work on display compares to their own art work in class. Then of course we will be making good use of the outside space to help further develop the 'buddy' relationships between the pupils!

The children should wear their school uniforms tops and own trousers/leggings and trainers suitable for the season. We also ask that all pupils bring a backpack style bag which they can carry to our picnic spot while leaving their hands free.

When organising school visits to enrich the curriculum and the education experience of the children, the school invites parents to contribute to the cost and we are asking parents/carers to contribute £13.00 per child for this visit. All contributions are voluntary, regretfully; if sufficient contributions are not received the school will have to consider cancelling the visit. Please note that school is subsidising the cost of this visit. Please log on to your ParentPay account to pay and to give your permission for school to take your child on this event. We cannot take anyone without permission.

From 1 April 2017 the cost of school visits for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium will be subsidized by school. Please logon to your ParentPay account to give permission and to pay the reduced amount. School will automatically top up this amount from the Pupil Premium funding.

Mrs Jones can offer a packed lunch for visits. This is free of charge for all Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils and is £2.10 for all other pupils. The packed lunch consists of:

Homemade sandwiches, Sausage Rolls, Cheese Straws, Vegetable Sticks, Homemade Bun, Water.

You will be prompted to enter your child's preferred sandwich filling when paying for this visit on ParentPay. Please enter either Tuna, Egg, Ham, Cheese or home (if you are proving a packed lunch from home) in the notes box.
