Class 2 Horrible Histories Theatre Visit 07.06.17

As part of the KS2 History curriculum, class 2 will be visiting the City Varieties theatre in Leeds to watch Horrible Histories Best of Barmy Britain on Wednesday 7 June. Barmy Britain is a brilliantly fun piece of educational theatre which explores the chronological story of Britain covering Roman, Medieval, Tudor, Georgian and Victorian periods.

We will set off from school at 9.00am – please can we ask that pupils are at school for 8.50am. The production is 11:00am – 12:00pm and we will stay and have our lunches before returning to school. We will be travelling by coach with seatbelts. Pupils will need to wear their school uniforms and sensible shoes.

Mrs Jones can provide a packed lunch for school dinner on this day. The packed lunch consists of Homemade sandwiches, Sausage Rolls, Cheese Straws, Vegetable Sticks, Homemade Bun, a Bottle of Water.

This will be added to the weekly Jacket Potato slips where you will be able to choose a sandwich filling.

From 1 April 2017 the cost of school visits for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium will be subsidized by school. Please log on to your ParentPay account to give permission and to pay the reduced amount. School will automatically top up this amount from the Pupil Premium funding.
