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Dear Parents / Carers,

We just wanted to make contact to keep you fully informed in regards to the upcoming Year 6 National Curriculum Assessment Tests (often still referred to as SATs).

The test week has been set nationally as beginning on the 8<sup>th</sup> of May 2017.

The timetable for that week will be as follows –

Monday 8 May 2017	English reading
Tuesday 9 May 2017	English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1: questions English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 2: spelling
Wednesday 10 May 2017	Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning
Thursday 11 May 2017	Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

In the run up to this period Year 6 will be undertaking a variety of consolidation and revision lessons, including a number of sessions being taught as a separate 'Year 6 only' class. In addition to this 'Revision Club' will continue to run every Tuesday after school up until test week.

During the 'test week' we will be inviting all Year 6 pupils into school at 8.20am for a 'Breakfast Club' in the school dining hall. This will be a relaxed start to the day, with snacks and juice, just to help settle nerves and prepare the group for the day ahead.

We ask that, as far as possible, all Year 6 pupils maintain full attendance in the run up to testing and that wherever possible please schedule non-urgent doctors / dentists appointments outside of school hours.
