Class 1 Stockbridge Visit 26 May 2017

On Friday 26 May, Class 1 will be returning to Stockbridge Technology Centre as part of our Science, Art and Healthy Eating studies on reconnecting children with food production. We will leave school just after morning registration and will return to school in time for lunch.

We will be travelling by coach with seatbelts. Pupils will need to wear trousers that you don't mind getting dirty – we will be digging and planting outside – and their school uniform tops. Children will also need waterproofs/sunhats and wellingtons or strong shoes. Please inform school of any specific special needs.
