Dear Parents / Carers,

I am aware that a number of you will be attending the Sherburn High School 'Year 6 Parents - What Happens Now?' parent forum tomorrow night.

Just in advance of this I am keen to address a number of issues relating to transition arrangements for our pupils making the move to Sherburn.

Sherburn High now advises all pupil participate in a three week transition period, attending High School for the entirety of this 15 day period. This year this is scheduled to occur from the week beginning Monday the 3rd of July.

During this three-week programme, students take part in a number of different activities to prepare them for life at Sherburn High School. From, team-building days to timetabled lessons, orienteering around the school and various exciting subject-based activities.

This will be the third year this system has been used by the High School, with favourable reports of its positive impact coming both from Sherburn themselves and other local feeder schools.

With this in mind we would just like to reassure you that we will be arranging our 'end of year' events to happen prior to this transition period, with the assumption that all pupils transferring to Sherburn High will be participating in the full three weeks of their activities. Following the three weeks with Sherburn pupils will return to us for the final two days of the term on the 24th and 25th of July.

Naturally, those pupils not transferring to Sherburn will be catered for within school during this period and we will work with other settings to ensure we fully support their transition arrangements. If you would like to discuss this further please do not hesitate to get in touch.
