Dear Parents/Carers,

East Barnby Residential 25th – 29th June 2018

I am delighted to announce that we are proposing to take our Years five and six to East Barnby Outdoor Education Centre from Monday 25th to Friday 29th June 2018. This is an excellent opportunity for your child to take part in an experience that will stay with them forever, a chance to be away from home with their friends and take part in challenging activities for the first time. It is an opportunity that ALL Y5/6 pupils should take part in.

I have taken away many school parties and it is wonderful to see children growing in confidence, developing their social and problem solving skills and becoming more independent. Health and Safety is vital and all activities are led by fully qualified and experienced staff.

The cost of the visit will be £335.00 which includes coach hire, accommodation, all equipment including hire of waterproofs, walking boots and wellingtons, all meals and tuition, transport to and from the centre and insurance. We would really like everyone to take part in this experience and therefore I have arranged for school to sponsor each child to the value of £135.00. The final cost to families is therefore £200.00 per child.

Families in receipt of Free School Meals at the time of the residential are entitled to assistance from the Authority with the accommodation, equipment hire, meals and insurance costs and are required to contribute only to the cost of coach hire (£20.00).

This year our visit is shared with Fairburn School. They will be staying in the same accommodation and we shall also undertake our programme of activities with them. This will be a superb opportunity for all our year groups to meet friends who could be going to the same secondary schools.

Past activities have included; sailing, beak scrambling, canoeing, surfing and climbing and a full brochure with activities and itinerary will be issued nearer the time.

We need to confirm the number of children wishing to go on the visit and ask you logon to your ParentPay account to give your permission and to pay the £20.00 deposit. Further instalments can be made on a weekly or monthly basis or you can pay in full nearer the time. We do ask however that the full amount is paid by the end of April 2018.

If you have any concerns about any of the information given in the letter then please do not hesitate in contacting school and I will gladly be of help. Please pay the deposit by Friday, 15th December so that I can confirm the number of places we need to the centre.
