## Whole School Summer Visit to Bridlington 12.07.19

On Friday 12<sup>th</sup> of July, the whole school will be going on a trip to Bridlington. We will start and end the day with a trip on the 'Road Train' which will transport us in style from Sewerby Hall to the beach, where we will spend a few hours on the sand.

We will leave school straight after registration - please arrive promptly so we can get away on time and will return slightly later than the regular end of the school day, arriving back for 4.30pm. We will be travelling by coach with seatbelts. Children can wear their own trousers/leggings/shorts etc. and school jumpers/cardigans. They will all need sensible shoes/trainers as we will be outside most of the day. All children will need to bring plenty of drinks (no glass bottles or cans), sun hats if it is hot and a waterproof coat if it isn't. Please apply sun cream before school if required. All pupils must bring along their own backpack, to allow them to carry their own lunch to and from the beach whilst leaving both hands free.

When organising school visits to enrich the curriculum and the education experience of the children, the school invites parents to contribute to the cost. The cost for this trip is £15.00 per child. All contributions are voluntary however if insufficient contributions are received we may have to consider cancelling this visit. Please note school has subsidized this visit. Please log onto your ParentPay account to pay for this visit and to give permission for your child to attend.

From 1 April 2017 the cost of school visits for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium will be subsidized by school. Please log on to your ParentPay account to give permission and to pay the reduced amount. School will automatically top up this amount from the Pupil Premium funding.

Mrs Jones can now offer a packed lunch for visits. This is free of charge for all Key Stage 1 pupils and costs £2.65 per pupil for those in Key Stage 2. The packed lunch consists of:

Homemade sandwiches, Sausage Rolls, Cheese Straws, Vegetable Sticks, Homemade Bun, A Bottle of Water

You will be prompted to enter your child's preferred sandwich filling when paying for this visit on ParentPay. Please enter either Tuna, Egg, Ham, Cheese or home (if you are providing a packed lunch from home) in the notes box.
